Nevada ranks **51st in the nation** for youth mental health services, struggling with **high rates of mental illness and low access to care** (Mental Health America, 2022). Statewide, there is just **one mental health professional for every 460 residents**, and **every county in Nevada** is federally designated as having a **mental health provider shortage** (UNLV/Brookings Mountain West, 2023).

This reality means that many individuals, particularly our youth, suffer in silence, unable to access the help they need. A shortage of psychologists and **a lack of options in mental health providers** further compounds the issue, leaving many feeling disconnected from care. Families often express **frustration at the lack of a wide range of treatment options**, making an already difficult journey even harder.

How the Avery Burton Foundation is Helping

The Avery Burton Foundation (ABF) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit founded to **bridge the gaps in mental health care** through **Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) training, education, and scholarships**. By providing community-driven solutions, ABF is actively working to make mental health resources more accessible and inclusive. Our programs include:

- **MHFA Training** that equips individuals to identify and support youth and adults in crisis.
